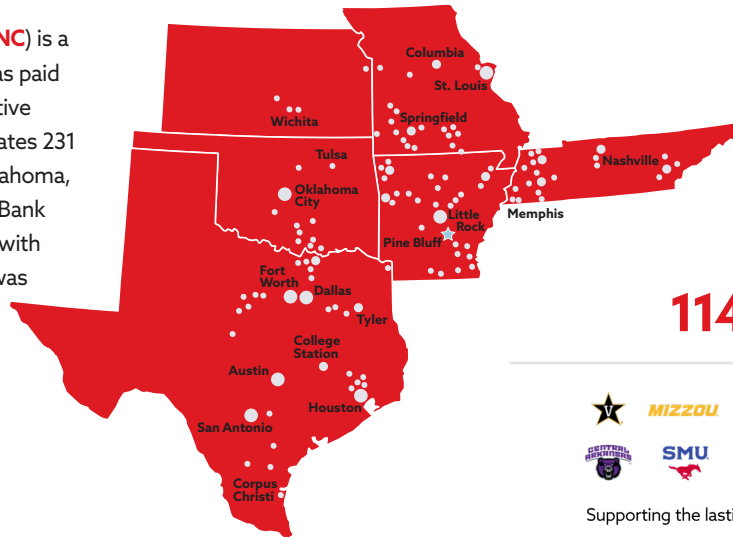




## Corporate Profile

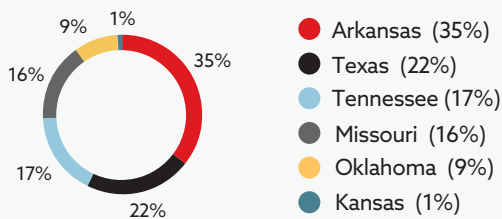

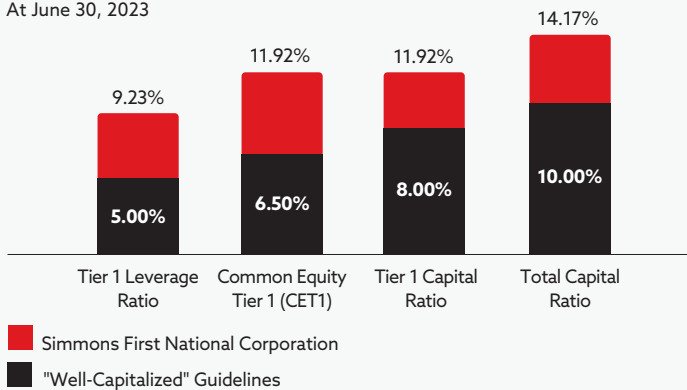
## Deposits by State

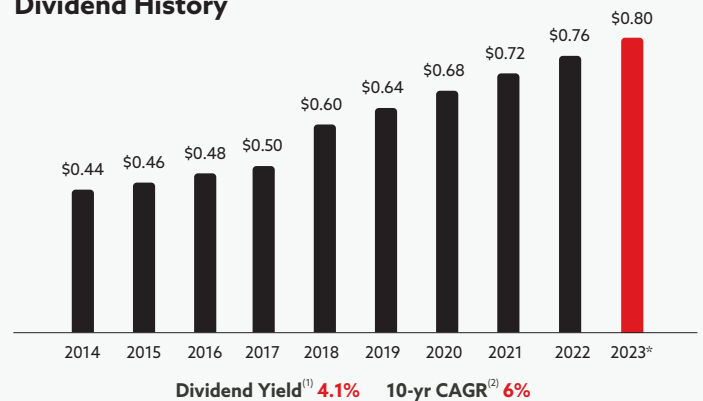
